



Minutes of the meeting held on
Monday 6th September 2021

1. **Minutes of the last meeting**

The minutes were approved and signed by the chairman.

2. **Matters arising:**

a. **League Singles Cup**

This had taken place on the Waterhouses Green on 29th August. A total of over £60 had been taken from the card game and donations for refreshments. Thanks were given to those who took part in organising the event.

b. **£5 Donations from league players**

Marilyn Sandall had made a collection totalling £70 after RSt had added his contribution. GK agreed to pass on the money to RSt.

c. **Green Maintenance**

RC had spoken to Mick Sumner of Kingsley Bowls Club, who named Chris Woods as having a tining machine for use on the green. RC would be arranging for the pickup of the machine after the season was over. This would be used to aerate the green and allow for the sowing of seed to improve the coverage. A donation would be required in exchange for borrowing the machine.

3. **End of Season Social**

RSt had agreed to investigate the possibility of organising a meal at Ye Olde Crown on Monday 4th or Tuesday 5th October. RSt was not present at the meeting to give an update on progress.

4. **Benches**

3 new benches had been purchased since the end of the 2019 season. These had been painted by RC and had been in use throughout the current season. RC reported that there was enough tarpaulin to cover the additional benches when they were stored at the end of the season.
Storage would be discussed at the next meeting.

5. **Any Other Business**

Safeguarding: PC noted that Lynn Hubbard was the club's Safeguarding Officer but had not played for the club in 2021. She was, however a member and could still be involved in any issues relating to safeguarding. It was not clear how much Lynn would be involved during the 2022 season, but potentially she would be a more active member.
